The purpose of this endowment fund is to provide advanced education at a college, university or trade school upon graduation. (R)

(R) Restricted Endowment Funds (income only use)

Contributions to one of these endowments are invested in a permanent fund, and only the income generated by the fund is available for use.

(U) Unrestricted Funds (income and principal used)

Contributions to one of these funds are placed in an investment account, and the income and principal generated by the fund is available for use. These funds are established by a resolution of an organization's Board of Directors.

(T) Temporarily Restricted Funds (income and principal used)

Contributions to one of these funds are placed in an investment account, and the income and principal generated by the fund is available for use. These funds are considered restricted until a qualifying expenditure is made that is consistent with the donor's wish.
